From The Board Of Trustees of The New Rochelle Public Library

The Library Board of Trustees has scheduled a Library Election/Budget Vote on **Tuesday, May 16, 2023**, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. at Board of Education polling places.

The vote will be:

- 1.To elect two members of the Board of Trustees to serve at large for the following terms:July 1, 2023 June 30, 2028 (5-year term)
- 2. To adopt an annual budget for the Library for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 June 30, 2024

SUMMARY

The proposed increase of **6.87**% in the tax levy translates to an increase of **\$417,724** to the current levy amount, or an annual increase of **\$24.07** per household for the "average" taxpayer (estimate furnished by the New Rochelle City Finance Department.) This increase constitutes one penny of every property tax dollar paid by New Rochelle property taxpayers.

Areas of growth in the proposed 2023/2024 budget relate primarily to mandated contractual increases tied to salary enhancements and benefits, utility costs and modest increases for materials, and the addition of one new full-time position, a Children's Librarian I (School-Age Outreach Coordinator.) This new position is aligned with our 2022 -2026 strategic goal to increase engagement of our school-aged children and teens.

New Rochelle Public Library Highlights

- New Rochelle Public Library (NRPL) ranks in the top 4 among the 38
 Westchester Library System (WLS) libraries in number of card holders, e-book
 circulation, total hours open and attendance at library sponsored programs.
- NRPL ranks in the bottom third of WLS libraries in expenditure on library materials and personnel, as a percentage of total operating expenses.
- 725,000 people visited our libraries in 2022 to access materials, attend programs, use study rooms, computers and WiFi.
- Over 600 children signed up for our 2022 Summer Reading Challenge recording over 152,00 minutes of reading.
- Over 2,000 teens were engaged in 426 programs in 2022 from 3D printing workshops to candy sushi making, video game tournaments, chess, board game nights, ukulele instruction and more.
- Through our Museum Pass program, over 800 patrons checked out free passes for admission to over 25 area museums and cultural institutions.
